

THAILAND VISIT (TOURIST) VISA – REQUIRED DOCUMENTS (From UAE)

1. Passport

Must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of travel.

Must have 2 blank visa pages.

Include copy of the passport bio page and UAE residence visa page.

2. UAE Residence Proof

Copy of valid UAE residence visa (minimum 3 months validity).

Copy of Emirates ID (front & back).

3. Photographs

2 recent photos, size 3.5 cm x 4.5 cm, white background.

Taken within the last 6 months.

No glasses or head coverings (unless for religious reasons).

4. Financial Documents

You must prove you can afford your stay in Thailand.

Provide one or more of the following:

Bank statement for the last 3–6 months, stamped by bank.

Salary certificate or employment letter (mentioning position, salary, joining date).

Trade license (if self-employed).

Sponsor's financial proof (if someone else is paying — include sponsor letter & bank statement).

Minimum recommended balance:

AED 5,000–7,000 per person (or equivalent).

5. Employment / Business Documents

Depending on your status:

If employed:

NOC / Leave letter from employer (mentioning travel dates).

If self-employed:

Trade license copy (and company letter if applicable).

If dependent:

Sponsor's letter + copy of sponsor's passport, residence visa & Emirates ID.

6. Family Applications

If applying with family:

Marriage certificate (for spouse).

Birth certificates (for children).
